Hon. Justice Rubby Opio Aweri joined the Judiciary as a Magistrate Grade I in 1983 and rose through the ranks to Justice of the Supreme Court (2015) a position he has held until the time of his death. As a career Judicial Officer, Hon. Justice Opio Aweri was appointed Judge of the High Court in 1998 and later elevated to a Justice of the Court of Appeal in 2013. At the time of his demise, he was the Chief Inspector of the Courts of Judicature.

Hon. Justice Rubby Opio Aweri has been described by many as a great towering legal mind who served the bench with boundless dedication, utmost humility and commitment for nearly four decades. No doubt that the Nation at large will miss his noble service.

He had major interest in Law & Practice; Land Law, Civil Litigation, Criminal Law, Environmental Law and Management. Born on May 31, 1953 in Kachung village, Agwata Sub-county, Dokolo County, Lira District. The Justice was espoused to Mrs Susan Acen Aweri, and has left ten children.


